# Question: How can I get my OMA password? Solution:

- Call the DMH Help Desk at (213) 351-1335.
- OMA Login = IS Login

# Question: How do I enter a Baseline / KEC / 3M? Solutions:

- Schedule a training class
- Obtain the User Manual

# Question: Why doesn't the episode show up on screen?

#### Solutions:

- Double-check that the client has an open episode in the IS.
- Double-check that the open episode belongs to the provider number you are associated to. Submit a Rendering Provider Form to update the IS.
- OMA receives new episodes every two hours. Re-check for episode after 2 hours.

# Question: Why is the episode ID not highlighted or underlined?

#### Solutions:

- A Baseline has already been created for that episode.
   Check "Baseline Exists" field at end of episode line.
- Make sure that you are associated to the correct provider. If not, submit a Rendering Provider Form found here:

# Question: Why is the episode id showing with provider number only?

Example: Episode ID =  $\underline{1234}$  instead of  $\underline{1234A001}$ 

#### Solution:

- Go ahead and click on the provider number <u>1234</u> if the episode ID doesn't show up.
  - As long as it is the correct provider and the correct admit date, you should be able to proceed with creating the assessment.

# Question: How do I delete or fix an assessment if I made a mistake?

#### Solution:

 Fill-out and submit an "OMA Data Change / Deletion Form". OMA Data Change / Deletion Form can be found on the OMA Wiki page: <a href="http://www.dmhoma.pbwiki.com">http://www.dmhoma.pbwiki.com</a>

### Provider XML Submission to OMA

- Export of assessments from third-party applications
  - Examples: Caminar, SeginusABC
  - Format: XML (Extensible Markup Language)
  - □ Translation based on DMH-written specification (XSD)
- Submission using Secure Internet File Transfer
- Import of assessments into OMA
  - □ Create a unified database for submission to State
  - Assessments viewable within OMA after submission



### Provider XML Submission to OMA

#### Status

- Current XSD given to application developers;
   Updated XSD pending
- □ Import Process under development by DMH
  - Develop standards for assessment completeness
  - Validation of data against IS data
- □ Testing: September



## **OMA-to-State Reporting Process**

- Extract State-mandated measures from OMA
- Translate OMA data into State data structure (XML)
  - Based on State-written specification (XSD)
- Upload to State ITWS website in MHSA section
  - □ Process managed by DMH
- Certification determined by State
  - □ Expected Certification: August



### The Future of OMA

- OMA Upgrade
  - □ In Planning Stage
  - □ Target: December
  - □ One of our objectives: Improved Performance
  - □ Looking for User Input
- Support for Additional Programs
  - □ Specialized Foster Care (SFC)
  - □ Additional programs coming (FCCS, ACS)
