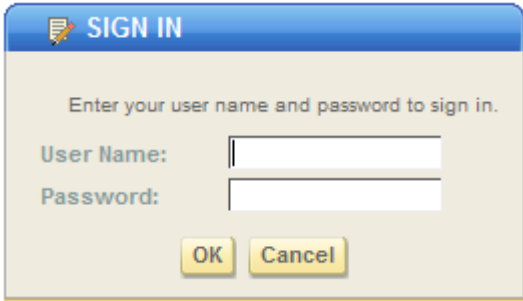
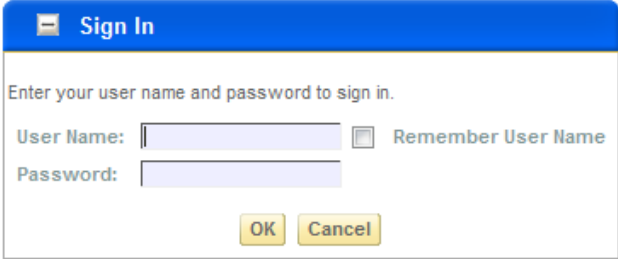

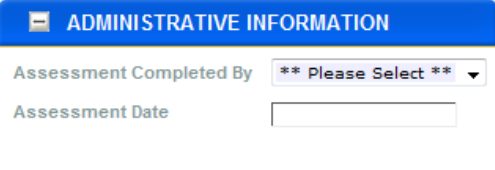
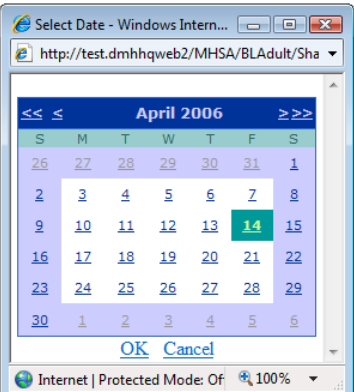



OMA V3 (Upgrade) NEW FEATURES

A list of some of the top OMA Changes you will see in OMA 3.0....

<p>CURRENT OMA</p> 	<p>UPGRADE: OMA 3.0</p> <p>Application will automatically populate the user's User Name every time user logs in by clicking on the "Remember User Name" check box.</p> 
<p>Partnership Date was set on the Admin section of Baseline.</p>	<p>Partnership Date is now part of the Add Client Program Screen</p> 
<p>Could not edit Assessment Completed by and Assessment Date fields.</p>	<p>Ability to edit Assessment Completed by and Assessment Date fields in the Admin Info Section.</p> 
<p>Calendar pops out on a separate screen after you click on the "Calendar Picker" Button</p> 	<p>Calendar comes up as soon as the date field is clicked. If you choose to type, the date field will auto-fill things like "/" for you</p>

<p>Users could not create an assessment on a client if client was transferred and the Episode was closed before the assessment was submitted.</p>	<p>Now, you have the ability to select an open or closed episode for current provider. Assessment date must be prior to discharge date for closed episodes.</p>
