CHANGES

Printable Forms

- 1) Printable Forms will now appear for all Age Groups when a user selects the "View" menu option: users can now print an entire assessment without having to select "Print" on each tab. To the left of each assessment there is a "View" link that will cause OMA to generate a PDF file that you can print. You will need a copy of a free PDF reader such as the Adobe Reader installed (see www.adobe.com if you don't have the Reader). Reminder: These PDF files contain Protected Health Information (PHI). The PDF files should be printed, and the printed copies should be secured with other client records.

Living Arrangements

- 2) A new validation will prevent users from entering a date range that would yield a negative number of days on the Baseline Living Arrangements page
- 3) A new validation will prevent users from entering overlapping dates on the Baseline Living Arrangements page
- 4) A new validation will require users to make a selection by checking one box in the TONIGHT on the Baseline Living Arrangements page.
- 5) A new validation will require users to check one box in the YESTERDAY column on the Baseline Living Arrangements page.
- 6) The validation on the Living Arrangements page has been adjusted to account for Leap Year. Total days must always equal 365.

3M Tickler

- 7) The 3M Tickler has been updated: Client discontinued from a program should not show up in the 3M Tickler.
- 8) The 3M Tickler has been updated: Client reestablished to a program should show up in the 3M Tickler.

Age Groups and "Aging Up"

- 9) There is an Incorrect Age Group fix to account for client aging between time of assessment and the time a paper assessment is entered into the OMA program. Previously, clients who aged up to the next Group (from TAY to Adult, for example) between the time an assessment was written up and the time it was entered into the OMA would create problems: OMA would show the age group at time of data entry. Now, OMA will show the form for the correct Age Group as of the partnership date for baseline, and the assessment date for KECs and 3M assessments.

Miscellaneous

- 10) Removed "N/A" value from question in Physical Section: 3)"Client receives needed medical services?" from drop downs for all Age Groups.
- 11) Changed all "NA" values in drop downs to "N/A."
- 12) Updated stored procedures for Add KEC and Add 3M pages to help increase performance.
- 13) Data handling changes were made behind the scenes to allow users to enter KECs and 3Ms for Baselines whose Episodes might be missing from the IS.
- 14) There were a number of cosmetic fixes made to the OMA.
