

## PEI Outcome Measures Application Requirements

*Updated May 6, 2011*

The Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Outcomes Measures Application is a ASP.NET-based web application designed to run on a Microsoft Windows-based PC using Internet Explorer 7 or later. JavaScript and browser cookies must be enabled in Internet Explorer in order for the application to function correctly. The use of any other web browser or operating system may result in the user interface functioning incorrectly or features being disabled. Therefore, it is not recommended.

A DMH Integrated System (IS) username and password is required to sign into the application. If you are accessing this application from outside of the DMH network, an Internet connection and a county-issued RSA SecurID credential will also be required.
