3	OMA Development Update (Omar Vasquez and Kara Taguchi)	 PEI OMA Version 1.5, incorporating MAP, TF-CBT, and Triple P and data collected by CiMH was released on February 9th. Only pulled in "active" treatment cycles as of last submission to CiMH. Providers can view historical data submitted to CiMH in the historical data view. Release scheduled for today that will add Mindful Parenting Groups EBP and associated questionnaires. FSP/FCCS OMA Update: Working on integrating IBHIS and IS client and episode data for FSP/FCCS OMA Question to users: How can we improve your user experience with PEI OMA? Answer: Provide sharepoint IDs on PEI deletion change requests like FSP/FCCS. It helps with tracking large clean up efforts. Answer: Make PEI OMA compatible with other browsers Answer: Allow users to return back to the page they were at when they were kicked out of the system so they can pick up where they left off when they sign back in. Answer: Have access to print reports through the PEI OMA system on what is pending for submission. Answer: Speed up the time it takes to get SecureID Tokens to enter data.

5	HEAT Tickets for PEI OMA (Odre Miller)	 Entering End of Treatment Information Before Posts Users call in HEAT tickets indicating that when trying to enter Post questionnaires, there is no option to select "Post" for questionnaire type. Once a user enters all required Pre questionnaires, the end of treatment button becomes enabled. In order to enter Post questionnaires, users must first enter End of Treatment Information. After End of Treatment Information is saved, users can enter Post questionnaires. They are required to acknowledge all Post questionnaires if the client completed the EBP. If the client dropped out, the treatment cycle can be closed without saving Posts. Browser Compatibility for Viewing Treatment Cycles: April OMA Newsletter featured an article about changing your browser to compatibility view to enable users to view treatment cycles. Some users were getting an error with some versions of Internet Explorer or your browser default settings. 7	Open Forum: Other User Issues and Concerns	 Question: Will today's release/update affect FSP/FCCS OMA users? Answer: No, today's release only affects PEI OMA. Question: Omar announced that FSP OMA will be supporting IBHIS, does that mean OMA will be linked to IBHIS? Answer: OMA will be able to recognize clients and episodes that exist in IBHIS like OMA does with the IS now. Question: In regards to FSP Partnership dates – say a client was county-wide approved for enrollment at a given date but this client wasn't opened or seen at our agency until a later date. What date should be used for the partnership date, countywide or the day we see them? Answer: The partnership date/ enrollment date is the first day that you deliver FSP services. The partnership date cannot predate the countywide authorization date as you need authorization to enroll.
